Bio:

Scenario:

Tally has a great love for football, and she interacts daily with the UW football team and staff, so football is on her mind quite frequently. Tally utilizes System X to plan football-watching events with her friends when they can't attend the games, and to look up stats about players and stay up to date on football news.

While on a break during one of her classes, Tally pulls out her phone and pulls up System X. She looks up the scores of a game currently going on, as well as some other football-related articles that catch her eye. She realizes that there is an important game tomorrow night that she wants to watch, but she can't afford to spend money on football tickets this month.
